Lashes By PRESCRIPTION

Since the drug Latisse received FDA approval in 2008, many doctors have prescribed it with good results. “Latisse makes a striking difference in lash density, length and thickness,” says J. Matthew Knight, M.D., a dermatologist in Orlando.
